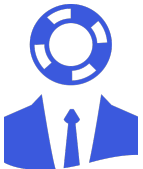
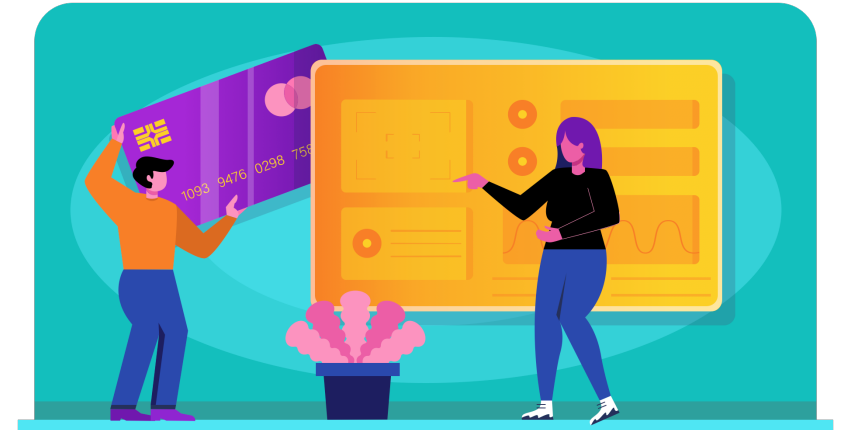
Levels of Procurement

- Micro-purchase
- Simplified acquisitions: the threshold for simplified acquisitions is generally capped at **\$250,000**.
- A procurement not fitting into the above levels = “regular purchase.



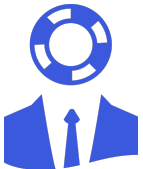
Indefinite Duration Indefinite Quantity (IDIQ) Contracts

- provide the government with flexibility
- streamline the procurement process



GSA Schedules

- **Long-term** contracts enable the federal government to negotiate more simplified contracts with private vendors.
- GSA Schedule contracts **>20%** of federal spending
